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What are PROMS?

Patient reported outcome measures (PROMs) are an increasingly important part of your treatment within the healthcare system.

PROMs are a series of simple questionnaires and assessments, sometimes known as 'scores'. You may be asked to complete PROMs at different stages of your care pathway via email.

Why am I asked to do them?

PROMs are a way for you, your surgeon and other healthcare professionals to monitor your reduction in symptoms and an improvement in your quality of life.

What do I need to do?

Once you have given your surgeon consent, you will be sent your scores to complete via email. They should take you no longer than ten minutes.

Email is essential to fill out your scores!
